











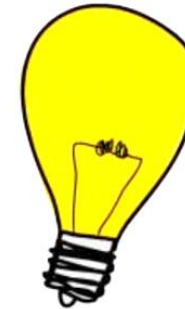


<b>RESEARCH</b>				
<p><b>Sources</b> Uses and compares multiple websites. Considers reliability of sources.</p>				
<p><b>Record Keeping</b> Lists all sources. Systematically collects and organizes information.</p>				
<p><b>Critical Thinking</b> Uses information to make personal connections that will further learning. Applies learning to create something new.</p>				

<b>PROCESS: GRIT</b>				
<p><b>Guts</b> Takes risks in learning. Chooses a topic that will be challenging.</p>				
<p><b>Resiliency</b> Demonstrates flexibility. Overcomes struggles. Approaches problems creatively.</p>				
<p><b>Integrity</b> Does best work. Information has been synthesized. Work is original.</p>				
<p><b>Tenacity</b> Persists. Chooses topic and sticks with it. Shows determination to see work through. Doesn't give up.</p>				

<b>ORAL PRESENTATION</b>				
<p><b>Voice</b> Speaks clearly in complete sentences. Loud enough to be heard by everyone.</p>				
<p><b>Posture &amp; Eye Contact</b> Stands up straight, looks relaxed and confident. Establishes eye contact during the presentation.</p>				
<p><b>Message</b> Shares information in a way that the audience can understand. Pronounces all words correctly. Practices beforehand.</p>				
<p><b>Listening</b> Looks at the speaker and attempts to understand the topic. Makes no distracting noises or movements.</p>
